

Local rules for the use of the CGC Inklab

1. Access and use of the CGC inklab is by permission of the CGC members.
2. Access is not permitted if in-inappropriately dressed ie no sandals or open footwear. No loose clothing is permitted. Eye protection, gloves and lab coat must be worn.
3. Ear protection must be used when noisy equipment are running.
4. Work in the ink lab is permitted only after being trained on the equipment to be used and being on the user list of that equipment. Each new user will be asked to contact the person responsible for that equipment to get trained before starting to work.
5. Entry and exit of the lab is controlled by access card. In case of emergency, emergency door release buttons are green. Red button close to the door set off alarms and/or cut mains power. In case of emergency, the nearest emergency exit is straight in front of the ink lab.
6. 24h work is allowed in the lab with exceptions:
 - Work with the gas station after 5PM and during the weekend is permitted only if working with air and/or nitrogen.
 - Work with solvent other than water is not permitted after 5PM or during the weekend except for quantities smaller than 50ml and exhausts running.
 - Work with quantities of solvent larger than 250ml is not permitted if alone in the lab at any time and if not all the exhausts are running.
